Brothers Building A Better Nation (BBABN) is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization dedicated to dismantling systemic barriers that negatively impact the lives of Black, Indigenous, and People of Color (BIPOC) males, ages 4 and older. We serve as a bridge from at-risk behaviors to better opportunities, with a strong focus on mental health, advocacy, education, and comprehensive support services.

Newark's youth face disproportionate challenges related to mental health, education, economic opportunity, and systemic inequities. BBABN works to:

- Increase access to mental health support
- Reduce the risks of incarceration and self-harm
- Empower families with education and advocacy

Through mentorship, intervention, and strategic community partnerships, BBABN is building a future where BIPOC youth can thrive.

OUR SERVICES

INTENSIVE IN-COMMUNITY THERAPY (IIC)

Personalized, in-community therapy for youth ages 4–21 to address emotional, behavioral, and social challenges.

BEHAVIORAL ASSISTANCE

Skill-building support focusing on emotional regulation, social skills, and family dynamics.

YOUTH MENTORSHIP

Guided mentoring programs based on Elements of Effective Practice for Mentoring, fostering resilience and personal growth.

CAREGIVER SUPPORT SERVICES

Parent and caregiver mentoring, group support, and education to strengthen families.

YOUTH TUTORING

Academic assistance tailored to each child's needs, helping them excel in school and beyond.

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT INITIATIVES

Events, workshops, and outreach programs to empower the Lower Broadway neighborhood.
