Intensive In-Community (IIC) Services:

IIC services are multi-purpose clinical interventions/support for families and children with behavioral and emotional challenges who are also receiving case management or mobile response and stabilization services. IIC services consist of incisive and goal oriented needs-based clinical interventions to provide stability for the youth and family within the home and community setting. IIC services are flexible as to location and time. Depending on the needs of the family, IIC services may either be provided within the youth's home or within the youth's community. IIC services are provided by a licensed masters' level clinician and is intended to stabilize and support the youth and family in an effort to deter more intensive interventions

Behavioral Assistant (BA) Services:

At Creative Perspectives, Behavioral Assistants (BAs) work as part of the children and family team under the direct supervision of a Licensed Clinical Social Worker (LCSW). BA services consist of specific, outcome-oriented interventions that are delivered as part of a comprehensive treatment plan prepared by a licensed clinical behavioral healthcare practitioner. BAs provide faceto-face interventions that focus on addressing specific target behaviors and improving overall emotional and behavioral regulation abilities for children who are receiving care management or mobile response and stabilization services. BA services are flexible as to location and time.
